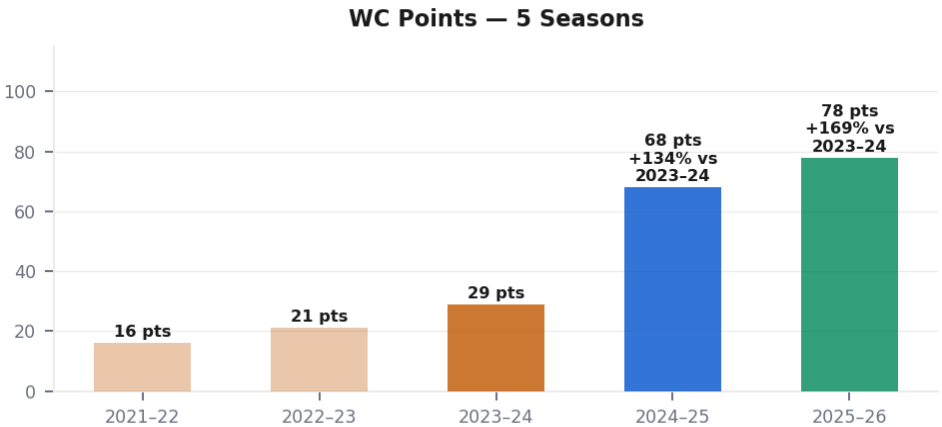
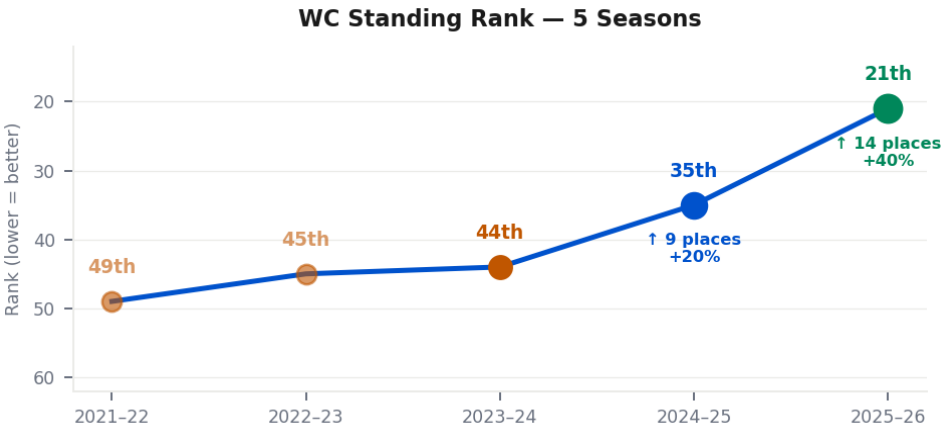

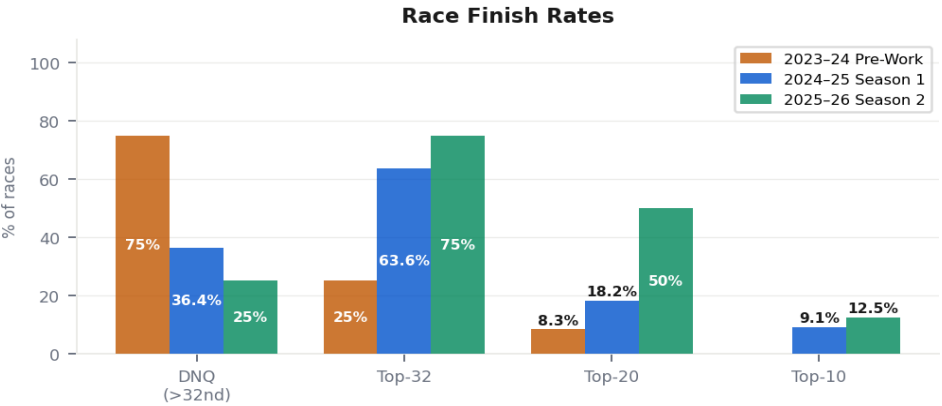
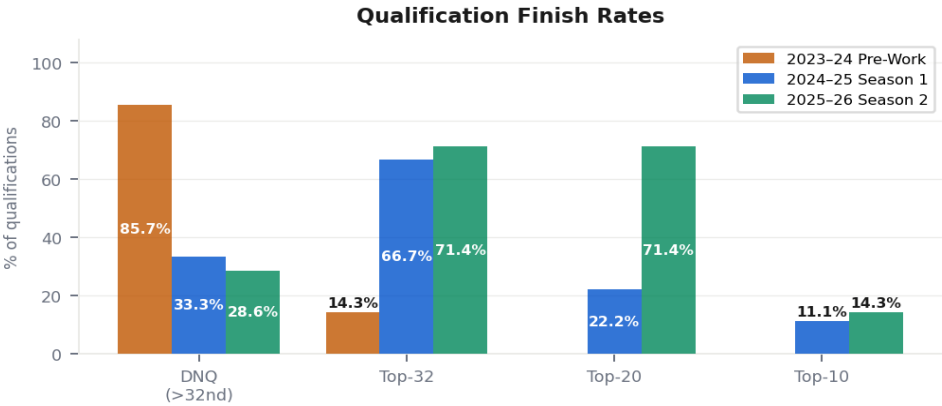

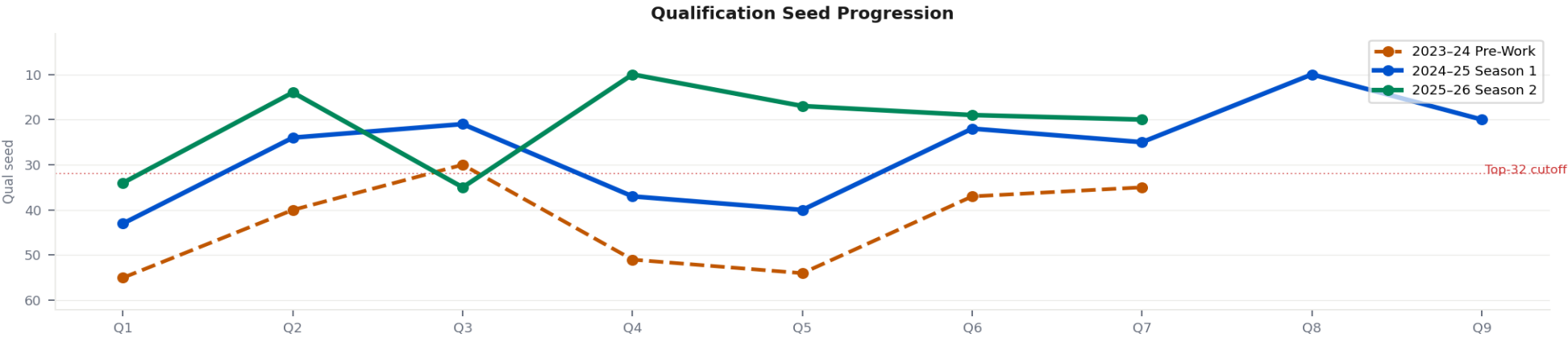
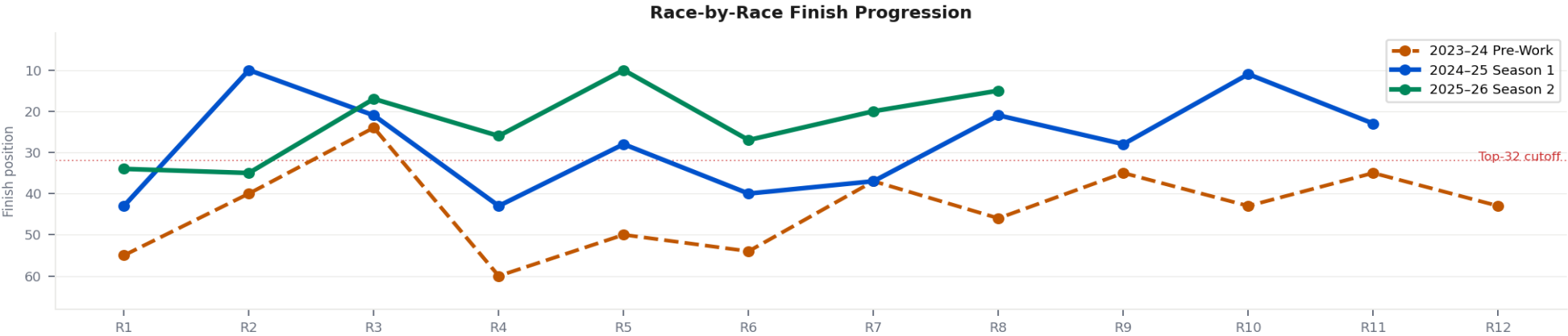

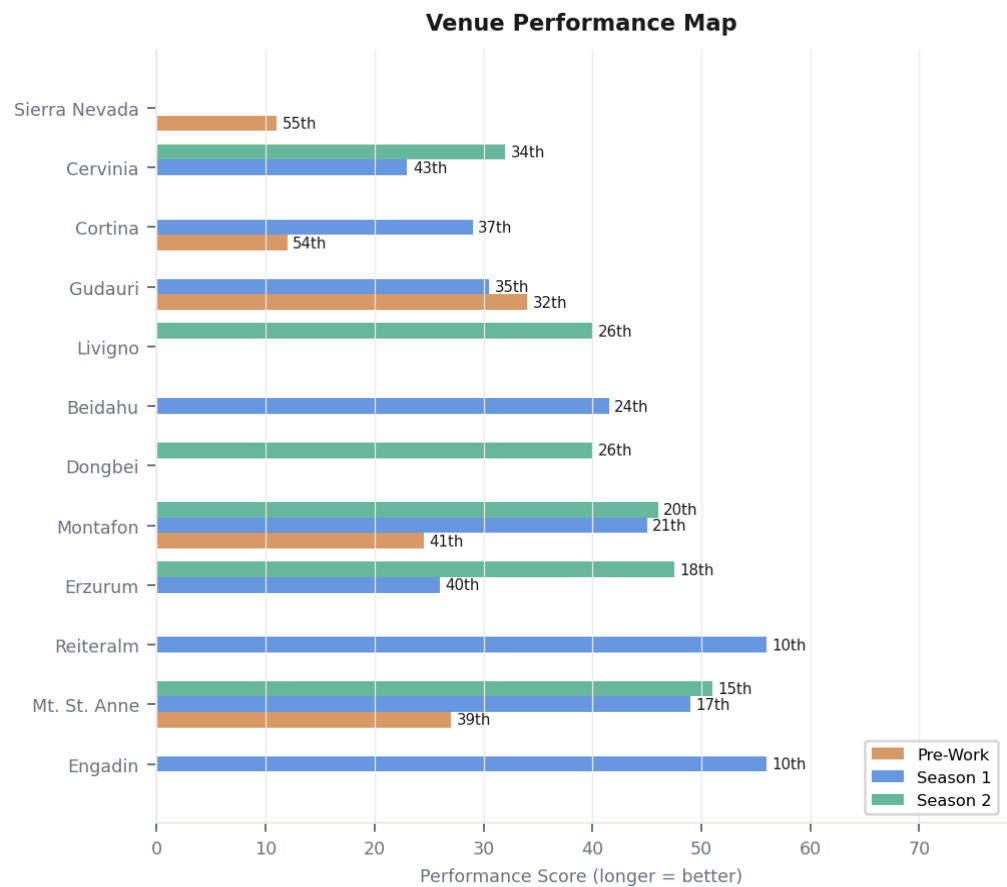

Key venue insights

Mt. St. Anne: consistent results across three seasons (11th–23rd). Strong venue for Huw.

Erzurum: improvement from 40th (S1) to avg 18.5th (S2) — biggest venue-level gain.

Montafon: solid across both seasons with top-20 representation.

Livigno (Olympic): 26th individual finish on debut — 10th in qualification demonstrates race-day pressure gap.

Sierra Nevada (baseline only): 55th–60th results reflect pre-intervention performance floor.
